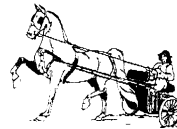

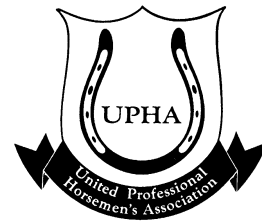

In order to show in a UPHA Classic, all horses and ponies must be registered with their appropriate breed registry and **MUST** be shown under their registered name.

UPHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: The professional trainer of a UPHA Classic entry must be an Active member of the UPHA in good standing, and their membership number must appear on the entry blank. If a non-professional is exhibiting the horse, they must be an Associate or Junior member of the UPHA, in good standing, and their membership number must appear on the entry blank.

RULES FOR ENTERING: A non-refundable Eligibility Fee of \$50 paid to the UPHA Office postmarked on or before April 1st of each year. After April 1st, the Eligibility Fee becomes \$100 per horse. Payment of the Eligibility Fee will be made in the name of the entered horse or pony and will make that animal eligible to compete in any and all UPHA Classics classes held that year. Eligibility remains with the animal throughout the year should transfer of ownership occur. Eligibility Fees collected will be used as prize money in the UPHA Classic Grand Championships. All Eligibility Fees collected within a breed will be used in that breed's championship classes.

The entry fee for each qualifying class is \$100 and is made in two payments. The first payment, the Declaration Fee, is \$50 and must be made by the entry closing date of the particular horse show. The second payment, the Starting Fee, is also \$50 and is due 24 hours prior to the class, whenever practical. All entry fees, or partial entry fees, are added to the total purse of the class.

Horse shows may choose to host a \$250, \$500 or \$1000 Added Money Classic. The entry fee for all UPHA Classic classes is \$100 regardless of the amount of Added Money offered.

All monies collected in each Classic will be dispersed in that class. Prize money in a \$500 or \$1000 Added Money Classic is divided as follows: \$300 is deducted from the total, with \$100 going to fourth, fifth and sixth places. Of the balance, 50% is paid to first place, 30% to second place, and 20% to third place. If there were only 2 entries, the total prize money would be split 60% and 40%. If only 3 entries show, the total prize money the original percentages would apply, without the \$300 deduction. In case of only one entry, that entry would receive 100% of the total.

Prize money in a \$250 Added Money Classic would be broken down in the same percentages as the other UPHA Classic classes, however, only \$50 would be awarded to the fourth, fifth and sixth places.

TO BE ELIGIBLE for competition in any UPHA Classic Grand Championship, a horse or pony must have place first through sixth in any UPHA Classic qualifying class, and both the owner and trainer of the entry must be an Active or Associate member of the UPHA.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The ASAW Summerfun Horse Show, the Charity and its Class Sponsors will not be responsible for any damages to person, animal or property at the Show, nor shall they be liable for any accidents or injuries sustained by persons or animals on the show grounds at any time. Neither will they be responsible for any vehicle or any equipment which is lost or damaged.

Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges and/or officials on the part of the exhibitor shall forfeit his entry, stall fees and prize money. The Horse Show Committee shall have the power to bar an offender from further competition and have him/her and his entire exhibit removed from the grounds. The Horse Show shall not be held liable for damages of any kind as a result of such action, and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry.

Horses must be kept under control and if not, at the discretion of the judges, they may not be allowed to compete. Owner will forfeit entry fees in this case.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE

All horses shipped into the State of Wisconsin must have the required health certificates, issued by a Veterinarian from the state of origin, available for inspection during the show. These must be in accordance with Wisconsin State Law.

NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED

Every horse and pony must have a negative coggins test within the 2006 year. Original must be available at the show.

POST ENTRIES

POST ENTRIES ENTRIES CLOSE JULY 3rd, 2006. ALL ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER JULY 1st SHALL BE ACCEPTED UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS: A post entry fee of \$25/horse will be levied on all entries postmarked after July 3rd, 2006.

Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it is subject to the rules and regulations of the ASAW Summerfun Horse Show and the rules of US Equestrian. No entries will be admitted for exhibition until the entry blank is duly signed by the EXHIBITOR, TRAINER and OWNER. POST DATED CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. THERE WILL BE A \$25 FEE FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS. NO EXCEPTIONS! NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. The Show Committee reserves the right of declining to accept any entry or entries and to return any and all entrance fees. The Show Committee may also prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any owner or stable employee or horse from the ring or grounds without liability of any kind.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to cancel any classes, when there are less than five entries, the property of different owners, and to combine or divide any class or classes should such be in the best interest of the show.

REGISTRATION PAPERS

US EQUESTRIAN/ASHA MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Effective 12/1/84, a copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THE SHOW NUMBER IS RELEASED. Exception- -Horses shown in US Equestrian Regular Member Shows prior to December 31, 1973 and Saddlebred-type ponies. A PHOTOCOPY OF HORSE'S REGISTRATION PAPER MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. A PHOTOCOPY OF THE OWNER, TRAINER, & RIDER CURRENT US EQUESTRIAN MEMBERSHIP CARD MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRIES, AS WELL AS A CURRENT ASHA MEMBERSHIP CARD FOR OWNER AND TRAINER.

REFUNDS

Exhibitors canceling their entries after July 4th shall forfeit their entry fee and stabling charge. During the course of the show entry fees may be refunded only if the horse scratched is examined by the Official Show Veterinarian and certified unable to show. No refunds will be made during the show. NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.

FEED AND BEDDING

Feed and Bedding will be provided by Quality Feed & Bedding. If you wish to bed on STRAW, call Sandy at 920-866-2459 by July 1 to place your order.

OFFICE HOURS

Business hours will be from 8:30 A.M. until the last performance of the evening; however, the office will be closed one hour prior to each performance. All changes must be made before that time. Check posted office hours for any additional changes.

STAKE AND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

A LISTING IN THE HORSE SHOW PROGRAM DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN ENTRY. ALL CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRIES MUST BE DECLARED AND PAID FOR IN THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THE HORSE WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW. THIS APPLIES TO STABLES WITH OPEN CHECKS.

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW IN A STAKE OR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS, A HORSE OR PONY MUST BE PROPERLY ENTERED, SHOWN AND JUDGED IN A QUALIFYING CLASS IN THE SAME DIVISION. JACKPOT CLASSES DO NOT APPLY. ENTRIES FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP & STAKE CLASSES, LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK, MUST BE MADE AND PAID FOR BEFORE 5:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, FOR SATURDAY NIGHT CLASSES. ENTRY FEES FOR ALL OTHER CLASSES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY BLANK, OR THE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED TO THE SENDER.

Exhibitors qualifying more than one horse may elect to show only one horse back without penalty.

If a Championship entry is paid by the deadline but is subsequently cancelled, no refunds will be given without an excuse from the official veterinarian.

SCRATCHES

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH EXHIBITOR TO OFFICIALLY SCRATCH ENTRIES IN ANY EVENT IN WHICH THEY DO NOT PARTICIPATE. THIS INCLUDES ALL STAKE AND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES.

A \$25.00 FINE WILL BE LEVIED FOR FAILURE TO SCRATCH AN ENTRY AT LEAST TWO HOURS PRIOR TO SHOW TIME. IF A CLASS IS SUBSEQUENTLY DIVIDED, A \$100.00 FINE WILL BE LEVIED.

DIVISION OF CLASSES

All pleasure driving classes will be divided at 15 or over. All other classes will be divided according to US Equestrian rules. In a divided class, separate trophies and ribbons will be awarded. Notification of intent to divide will be made one hour prior to the start of the session.

SUBSTITUTIONS

Under no circumstances will substitutions of entries be permitted, except as provided by the US Equestrian Rule Book.

WARM-UP AREA AND SHOW RING

Footing for the warm up area and show ring will consist of dirt and shavings.

GOLF CARTS

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

WHEELED TOYS/VEHICLES

Bikes, skate boards, roller skates, scooters or any type of wheeled toy/vehicle is prohibited from the horse show grounds for any individual under the age of 16. This is being done for the safety of all individuals and horses participating in or watching the horse show.

PASSES

An \$10.00 EXHIBITOR DONOR BADGE is available for admittance to all performances and the exhibitor parties.

DOGS

All dogs must be kept on a leash. The owner of any dog found loose on the horse show grounds will be fined \$25.

STABLING

ATTENTION STALLS WILL BE AVAILABLE AFTER 8:00 A.M.
ON TUESDAY, JULY 25

STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED AT THE DISCRETION OF
THE SHOW MANAGEMENT.

Permanent box stalls with doors and tack stalls will be provided at a cost of \$100.00 per stall. All stall rent must be paid at time of entry. EACH HORSE ENTERED IN A CLASS MUST HAVE A STALL. All tack stalls must be paid for in addition to the number of horses entered.

Please note: Shavings will be available on the grounds. Fiberboard is available. If you would like straw you need to preorder it. Contact Quality Feed and Bedding.

Any person altering in any way the stabling facilities provided by the management without express permission of the Show Manager or Grounds Manager may be evicted from the grounds for the duration of the show or fined \$100. Anyone found nailing tarps to barn will be billed for new tarps.

ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

All connections must be approved by State Fair Park officials and must meet state and national codes. The grounds manager will be advised of violations and will notify the offender. If corrections are not made, power will be disconnected to the individual exhibitor.

CONTACT WITH JUDGES

No exhibitor may confer with the Judges unless accompanied by the Show Steward.

CLASSES BY DIVISION

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. All classes will be shown in order listed. Any changes deemed necessary by the horse show committee will be made in accordance with the US Equestrian regulations.

All horses shown in these divisions must be registered with the US Equestrian or the Canadian American Saddle Horse Registry. They must be entered in their full registered name with registration numbers and under the names of the owner record. Horses shown in a regular member show prior to December 31, 1973, and ponies are excepted.

AMATEUR CARD

ALL AMATEURS, over age 18, must have available for inspection, a current US EQUESTRIAN AMATEUR CARD or make proper application at the show office one hour prior to class. Certification must be renewed annually.

WISCONSIN OWNED

In order to qualify for this class the registered owner and exhibitor of the horse must be a Wisconsin resident at the time the class is held. A "Wisconsin resident" is a person who is registered to vote in Wisconsin or qualified to register to vote in Wisconsin, and who declares Wisconsin his/her state of residence for state and federal income tax purposes. If the registered owner is a minor, his/her custodial parent(s) must meet the above criteria. (The location where the horse is trained and/or boarded is immaterial.)

ACADEMY CLASSES

Academy Classes are open to riders who have not competed in any classes other than academy classes or at a private show. Riders are to wear jodhpurs or dark pants, shirt, tie and jodhpur boots or sturdy shoes. (Sweater or seater vests are permitted. No habits, fitted vests or hats.) A rider's age is that as of December 1, 2005. Riders are to be judged on equitation skills only.

JUDGING AND PRIZE DISTRIBUTION

Six ribbons will be awarded in all other classes. Checks will be mailed to the owner/rider of the winning horse Any error in payment will not be corrected until September 1, 2006 after which unpaid premiums will be forfeited to the show. Checks not cashed by September 1, 2006 will be forfeited.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. Also exempted from this requirement are citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 8) USEA beginner novice division; and 9) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

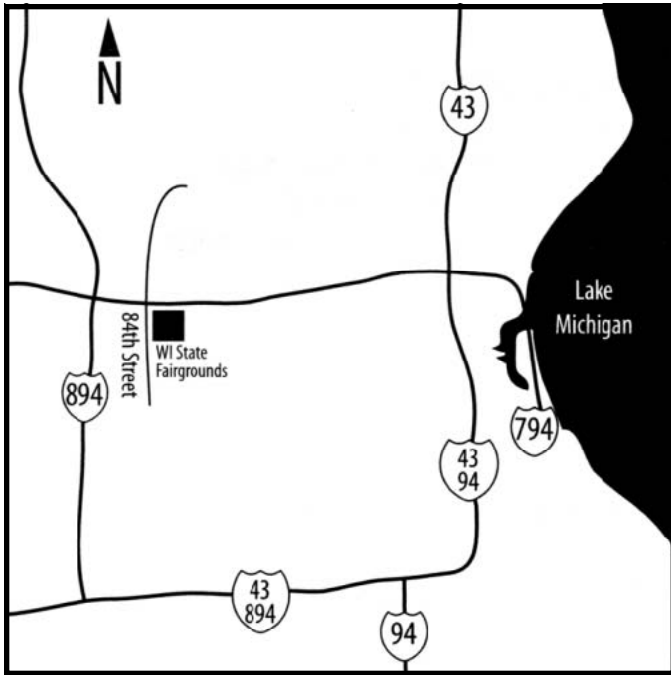

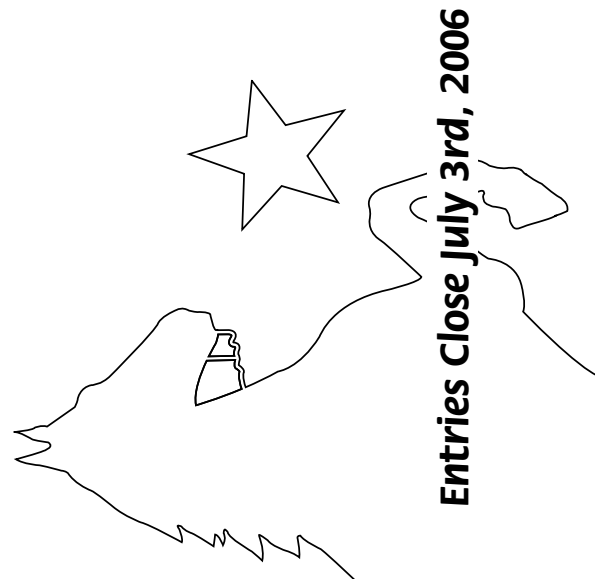
