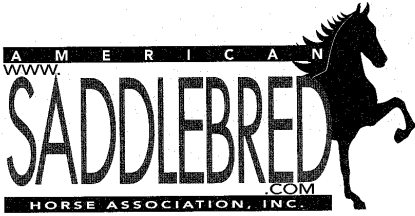


ASHA Regional Championships – How You Can Participate



The American Saddlebred Horse Association has named Mid-America Mane Event a Regional Championship show and 22 classes are designated as Regional Championships (marked with a bullet [•] on the class schedule). The Regional Champion will be determined by the highest placing qualified horse, which will receive a neck ribbon, championship ribbon and take a victory pass.

HOW HORSE QUALIFIES: Horse must compete and receive a ribbon (1st through 8th) in the same section (qualifying class or championship) within the Saddlebred division in three separate competitions within Region 5 (Illinois, Missouri, Kansas, Colorado) between September 5, 2007 and October 1, 2008. Competitions need not be USEF but must be listed and results recorded in the ASHA database of competitions. (To check if a horse's wins are listed in the ASHA database, visit www.saddlebred.com and click on Competitions.) Owner of horse must be current member of ASHA. If a horse has been sold during the qualifying period, the records go with the horse.

IF HORSE IS QUALIFIED IN MULTIPLE REGIONS: Horse may compete for only one Regional Champion title a year, even if exhibiting at more than one such competition. If a horse is qualified in more than one region, the owner must declare the one region in which the horse will compete for a Regional champion title. Even if horse does not win in an earlier declared Regional Championship, it may not compete for a Regional Champion title at a different show in the same year.

HORSE MUST BE DECLARED: In addition to being entered on the regular horse show entry blank, for a horse to compete for a Regional Champion title a Declaration of Intent to Compete form (see opposite side) must be filled out, signed and submitted to the horse show along with the regular entry blank. Horses without a Declaration form on file at the show office will not be considered for a Regional Championship title.

NO RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS: Previous residency requirements for horse's stabling, owner, rider/driver and trainer no longer apply.

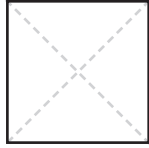

Enclose copy of registration papers showing proof of current ownership for each entry, plus copy of current USEF membership card for each owner/exhibitor/trainer and copy of ASHA membership card for each owner/trainer. (Miscellaneous and Walk/Trot classes exempt.) All horses must have a negative Coggins test within the past 12 months.

FEDERATION Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification
This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition Mid-America Mane Event Show to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (“Harm”).

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR 318 and EV113, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child’s participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child’s behalf

I AGREE that “the Federation” and “Competition” as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE to be bound by all applicable Federation Rules and all terms and provisions of this entry blank.

Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a USA EQUESTRIAN-recognized Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the “Federation”) and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State.
