Stalls are available after 12 noon Friday by entry form reservation only. Open check required at check in along with registration papers and negative Coggins. Entries close July 10th. Any entries post-marked after entry form closing date will be assessed a post entry fee.

THE OPEN PLEASURE CLASS BEFORE THE ACADEMY PERFORMANCE IS POST ENTRY EXEMPTED.

This show is judged under USEF rules, which are available for inspection in the show office. Copy of registration papers must be available for horses entered in the "B" rated section. A copy of current UPHA membership card is required for riders in the UPHA Challenge Cup class.

Age of rider as of December 1, 2009.

NOVICE riders cannot have won more than 3 blue ribbons for both the "B" rated and academy novice riders classes.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Open to horses which have been shown in a qualifying class in their respective division.

Wash rack is not available, but outside washing is.

**ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS ALLOWED
ON SHOW GROUNDS.**

Two minute gate hold between classes will be enforced. The gate person should be notified of tack changes at least four classes ahead before the change is needed.

FEES: Stalls-\$65.00 for the weekend, comes with 2 bags of shavings

Additional shavings available at \$8.00 per bag

Classes: \$25.00

Championships: \$30.00

Office Fees: \$15.00 per rider

Pattern classes in the academy section are open to "B" riders as well.

ACADEMY SECTION

WORKOUTS:

Walk and trot section:

1. Stand up in a two point position and hold until judge asks you to sit.
2. Trot a straightaway showing one change of diagonal. Rider must start on the correct diagonal.
3. Judge may ask rider to show they know the difference between the curb and snaffle rein. In the event the rider has a German martingale the rider must know correct term for that type of bridle.

Walk/trot/canter section:

4. On the straightaway, trot half way on the correct diagonal, stop, and canter the remainder on the correct lead.
5. On the straightaway, canter half way on the correct lead, stop, & trot the remainder on the correct diagonal.
6. Trot a figure eight
7. Trot a serpentine
8. Canter the straightaway on the correct lead, stop and trot a circle.
9. Trot the straightaway on the correct diagonal, stop, and canter a circle.

RULES AND EXPLANATIONS

1. This show is open to riders who have not competed in a show other than a private stable show or academy classes wherever held, OR who have only competed in walk-trot leadline or showmanship at halter in open shows.
2. Attire: Jodhpurs or dark pants, shirt, tie, jodhpur boots or sturdy shoe. Sweater vest or sweater permitted. Helmets are recommended and REQUIRED FOR ALL 10 UNDER RIDERS. (Per UPHA Guidelines)
3. The horse must be stable owned, leased, or a sale horse and of the academy type. Horses in the academy section MUST BE USED IN A LESSON PROGRAM
4. Equipment: Horse must be shown in appropriate saddle. Normal academy equipment (ie martingales, snaffles, ect.) permitted in academy classes. Wraps, shin boots, bell boots or knee boots are permitted.
5. Age of Rider as of December 1, 2009
6. Riders may enter only one equitation class and may qualify for a championship in their division. Walk and trot riders may only enter walk-trot pleasure classes. Walk/trot/canter riders can only enter walk/trot/canter pleasure classes.

8. Fee: Office fee per rider \$15.00

Entry fee each qualifying class . . \$25.00
Championship Classes \$30.00

UPHA CHAPTER 3/4 & 10 ACADEMY EQUITATION CHALLENGE

In a joint effort to help educate riders and promote equitation at the academy level, UPHA Chapter 10 along with Chapter 3/4 have joined forces to create the UPHA \$750 Academy Equitation Challenge.

Three shows throughout the year will host qualifying classes for Advanced and Intermediate academy riders. The class will consist of rail work followed by a standard workout. Riders who finish first or second in the qualifying classes are eligible to show in the \$750 championship class that will be held at the November UPHA Chapter 10 Academy Horse Show in Elgin, Ill on November 13th and 14th. Two US Savings bonds will be awarded to the first and second place riders with \$500 going to first and \$250 going to second .

Following the rail work riders will be asked to perform a standard four loop serpentine.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

- Championship class 32:** All riders from class 25
- Championship class 33:** Top 3 ribbons from class 26, 27a, & 27b.
- Championship class 34:** Top 4 ribbons from class 29, and 30.
- Championship classes 35-44:** any entry that has shown in their respective qualifying class.
- Championship class 53:** All riders from class 49
- Championship class 54:** All riders from class 50
- Championship class 55:** All riders from class 51
- Championship class 68:** Top 4 ribbons from class number 61A & 61B
- Championship class 69:** All riders from class 62
- Championship class 70:** Top 3 ribbons from class number 65, 66, & 67.

MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO OPEN UP REQUIREMENTS FOR ACADEMY CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES TO HELP FILL ANY CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

General: All riders will work both ways of the ring at the same gaits required in the class.

Leadline: Riders will be led in at a walk and worked each way of the ring at both the walk and the trot separately. The rider will be individually trotted past judge. Riders are expected to post, but correct diagonals are NOT required.

Walk/trot Maiden: This class is for the rider who has NEVER shown away from home stable shows except for leadline.

Novice walk/trot/canter: Open to academy equitation riders that have not won three blue ribbons in walk/trot/canter equitation classes.

Walk/trot/canter: Correct diagonal required. Correct leads required.

Walk/trot: Correct diagonals required.

Horsemanship classes: to be judged on horse's manners and suitability. Horsemanship is paramount. The overall appearance of any pleasure horse should depict a horse that enjoys what he is doing.

A. Saddle seat pleasure: Designated for horses of the saddlebred type, meaning their headset, motion & presence.

B. School horse pleasure: Designated for non saddlebred/ non-saddle seat type or older school horses. Horses that depict a "hunt seat" type headset. Horses that exhibit higher headsets, or saddlebred type of travel will be penalized.

Open Pleasure class: open to all instructors/trainers (*not a rated class*). Horse only to be judged. Must give the appearance of a saddle seat type horse. Designed to give an instructor/trainer the opportunity to show a new lesson horse or school one if needed in a show ring environment. Dress requirement is minimal. Jodphurs, jodphur boots, hair neatly tied back. No suit or academy attire required. Horse can be entered in more than one Open class per day-no post entry fee.

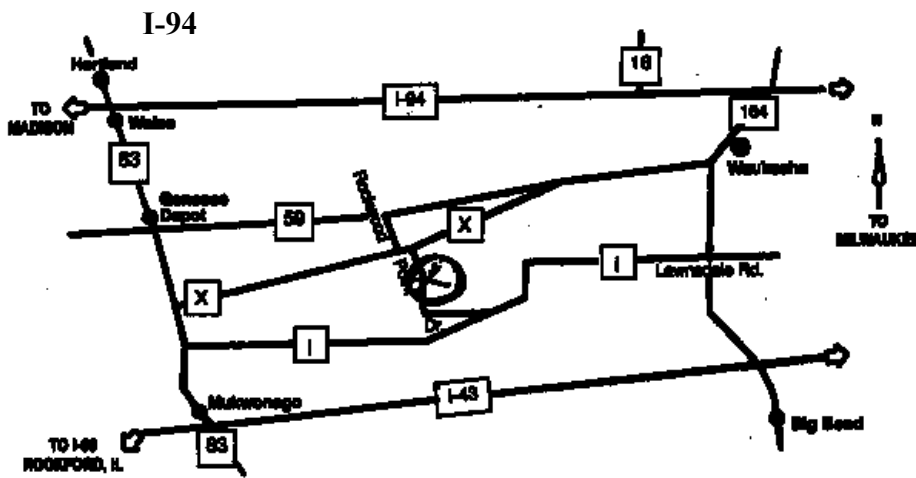
