## **RULES and REGULATIONS**

The Glen Valley Classic Horse Show will not assume any responsibility for damages to person, animals, or property at the show, nor will it be liable for any accident or injury sustained by a person or animal on the show grounds at any time. In addition, it will not be responsible for any lost or damaged vehicle.

Horses must be kept under control. If they are not, they may be barred from competition and entry fees will be forfeited.

Every class offered which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian Federation rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

## **HEALTH CERTIFICATE**

All horses shipped into the State of Wisconsin must have the required health certificates issued by a veterinarian from the state or region. These must be available for inspection during the show and be in accordance with Wisconsin State Law. Negative coggins test required for each horse.

## **DIVISION OF CLASSES**

The show committee reserves the right to cancel a class if there are fewer than five entries, and to combine or divide a class should this be in the best interest of all. Driving classes will be divided at over 18 and all pleasure under saddle classes at over 24. In case of a split, both will be judged as separate classes with the exception of championships and stake classes.

## **ENTRIES/POST ENTRIES**

Entries close June 10, 2010. Entries postmarked after this date will be accepted under the following condition: A post entry fee of \$10 per entry will be levied on each entry postmarked after June 10, 2010. A horse entered by the closing date may be entered in additional classes provided the class does not have to be divided to accommodate it.

Refunds on class entry fees will be given only with a veterinary certificate. No refunds on stall fees.

Post dated checks are not acceptable. There will be a \$25 fee for all returned checks. There will be no exceptions to this rule. No telephone entries will be accepted. All e-mailed, faxed or mailed entries will not be processed until payment is received.

The show committee reserves the right to decline any entry and return the entry fees. This committee may prohibit any one from attending or showing a horse. It also may remove any owner, stable employee or horse from the ring or grounds without liability.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to scratch an entry for a class in which he or she does not intend to participate. This includes stake and championship classes. A \$25 fine will be levied for failure to scratch an entry two hours before show time. If a class is split there will be a \$100 fine.

## **STABLING**

Stabling includes all permanent or vinyl box stalls with doors. Bedding is not included. Bedding may be purchased at the show grounds. Bedding to be shavings only. No straw. Stalls will be available on Wednesday Afternoon.

## **WARM-UP AREA**

An outdoor and indoor warm-up area will be provided. The footing consists of lime stone and sand. The competition area footing will be the same as the warm-up area.

## **MEDICAL WASTE**

Competition managers should be aware of the laws in their state regarding the disposal of medical waste generated by veterinary practice. Non-compliance with these laws could result in stiff fines from the state. Sharps containers will be in each barn.

## OFFICE HOURS

The office will be closed 1 hour before each performance. Check posted office hours for additional open and closed times.

## CONTACT WITH THE JUDGE

No exhibitor will be permitted to confer with a judge unless he or she is accompanied by a member of the show committee.

## ACADEMY DIVISION

The purpose of this division is to introduce potential owners to the joys of showing horses and give riders the opportunity to gain experience in a fun horse show atmosphere. The UPHA Chapters 3/4 and 10 sanction these classes. A complete copy of the guidelines for these classes will be available at the horse show office.

## RIDERS

Riders in this division are students who are enrolled in a professionally operated program and are to be judged on their basic riding skills. Riders may NOT cross enter into any performance classes with the exception of driving classes. A rider who has shown in a regular division class and/or in a full riding suit at any show is prohibited from further participation in the Academy division with the exception of the Open Rider Pleasure classes (if applicable).

## RIDERS' ATTIRE:

All riders are encouraged to use safety helmets. ASTM/SEI Approved Safety helmets are the only acceptable headgear for academy riders. Helmets are required for ALL 10 and under riders (effective 01/07).

- Saddle Seat Attire: Jodhpurs or dark pants, shirt with a collar, tie, jodhpur boots or sturdy shoes. Sweater vest or sweater permitted; no fitted vests or derbies/hats. No full riding suits allowed.

## HORSES:

Horses are to be lesson-type horses. These horses must display the characteristics of such! Instructors are encouraged to own or lease their academy horses. Horses must **not** be in training. Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with martingale or a Pelham/full bridle. Appropriate saddles are to be used for the seat being ridden. Hoof-blackening and ribbon braids are optional.

Academy horses may cross-enter into other divisions at any show; however, show horses may not be entered into the Academy division. This means an academy horse is allowed to show in the Academy division and be cross-entered into other divisions (such as Pleasure, Country Pleasure, Pleasure Equitation) at the same show.

**CLASS #25 PARK PLEASURE CLASSIC**

The first five ribbon winners qualify for the Saddlebred Classic Grand Championships at the 2010 American Royal Horse Show. In order for an entry to compete in the championships, its owner and trainer must be active or associate members of the United Professional Horsemen's Association and the entry's respective breed association.

Each horse entering a classic class must have been made eligible by the payment of an eligibility fee to the UPHA Office by March 15. If the eligibility fee has not been paid, the horse may become eligible by payment of a \$50 fee to the show secretary. These fees will be added to the Grand Championship prize money in each respective division at the 2009 finals.

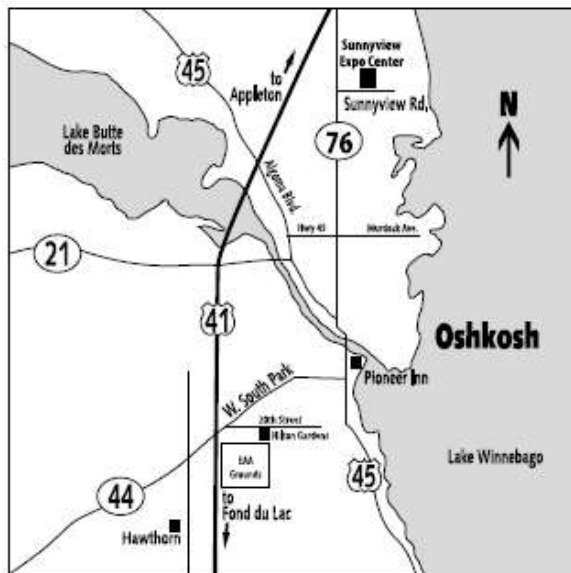
