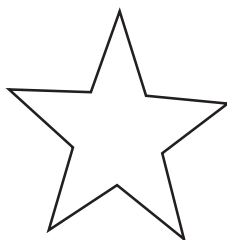

\$250 ADDED MONEY

Saddlebred Three-Year-Old and Under Classics

Class #53 Park Pleasure Classic

Class #133 Park Classic

In order to show in a UPHA Classic, all horses and ponies must be registered with their appropriate breed registry and **MUST** be shown under their registered name.

UPHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: The professional trainer of a UPHA Classic entry must be an Active member of the UPHA in good standing, and their membership number must appear on the entry blank. If a non-professional is exhibiting the horse, they must be an Associate or Junior member of the UPHA, in good standing, and their membership number must appear on the entry blank.

RULES FOR ENTERING: A non-refundable Eligibility Fee of \$50 paid to the UPHA Office postmarked on or before April 1st of each year. After April 1st, the Eligibility Fee becomes \$100 per horse. Payment of the Eligibility Fee will be made in the name of the entered horse or pony and will make that animal eligible to compete in any and all UPHA Classics classes held that year. Eligibility remains with the animal throughout the year should transfer of ownership occur. Eligibility Fees collected will be used as prize money in the UPHA Classic Grand Championships. All Eligibility Fees collected within a breed will be used in that breed's championship classes.

The entry fee for each qualifying class is \$100 and is made in two payments. The first payment, the Declaration Fee, is \$50 and must be made by the entry closing date of the particular horse show. The second payment, the Starting Fee, is also \$50 and is due 24 hours prior to the class, whenever practical. All entry fees, or partial entry fees, are added to the total purse of the class.

Horse shows may choose to host a \$250, \$500 or \$1000 Added Money Classic. The entry fee for all UPHA Classic classes is \$100 regardless of the amount of Added Money offered.

All monies collected in each Classic will be dispersed in that class. Prize money in a \$500 or \$1000 Added Money Classic is divided as follows: \$300 is deducted from the total, with \$100 going to fourth, fifth and sixth places. Of the balance, 50% is paid to first place, 30% to second place, and 20% to third place. If there were only 2 entries, the total prize money would be split 60% and 40%. If only 3 entries show, the total prize money the original percentages would apply, without the \$300 deduction. In case of only one entry, that entry would receive 100% of the total.

Prize money in a \$250 Added Money Classic would be broken down in the same percentages as the other UPHA Classic classes, however, only \$50 would be awarded to the fourth, fifth and sixth places.

TO BE ELIGIBLE for competition in any UPHA Classic Grand Championship, a horse or pony must have place first through sixth in any UPHA Classic qualifying class, and both the owner and trainer of the entry must be an Active or Associate member of the UPHA.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The ASAW Summerfun Horse Show, and its Class Sponsors will not be responsible for any damages to person, animal or property at the Show, nor shall they be liable for any accidents or injuries sustained by persons or animals on the show grounds at any time. Neither will they be responsible for any vehicle or any equipment which is lost or damaged.

Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges and/or officials on the part of the exhibitor shall forfeit his entry, stall fees and prize money. The Horse Show Committee shall have the power to bar an offender from further competition and have him/her and his entire exhibit removed from the grounds. The Horse Show shall not be held liable for damages of any kind as a result of such action, and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry.

Horses must be kept under control and if not, at the discretion of the judges, they may not be allowed to compete. Owner will forfeit entry fees in this case.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE

All horses shipped into the State of Wisconsin must have the required health certificates, issued by a Veterinarian from the state of origin, available for inspection during the show. These must be in accordance with Wisconsin State Law.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS 1. Horse entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables.

Horse not in compliance with the rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reaction, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management when requested.

NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED

Every horse and pony must have a negative coggins test within the 2023 year. Original must be available at the show.

OFFICIAL TIMER

The horse show Barn Announcer will be appointed as the "official timer" of the in gate.

POST ENTRIES

ENTRIES CLOSE JUNE 26th, 2023. ALL ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER JULY 1st SHALL BE ACCEPTED UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS: A post entry fee of \$50/horse will be levied on all entries postmarked after JUNE 26th, 2023 NO EXCEPTIONS. If entire barns entries are received the week of July 10th post entry will be \$100 per head.

Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it is subject to the rules and regulations of the ASAW Summerfun Horse Show and the rules of US Equestrian. No entries will be admitted for exhibition until the entry blank is duly signed by the EXHIBITOR, TRAINER and OWNER. POST DATED CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. THERE WILL BE A \$50 FEE FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS. NO EXCEPTIONS! NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. The Show Committee reserves the right of declining to accept any entry or entries and to return any and all entrance fees. The Show Committee may also prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any owner or stable employee or horse from the ring or grounds without liability of any kind.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to cancel any classes, when there are less than five entries, the property of different owners, and to combine or divide any class or classes should such be in the best interest of the show.

OFFICE HOURS

Business hours will be from 8:00 A.M. until the last performance of the evening; however, the office will be closed one hour prior to each performance. All changes must be made before that time. Check posted office hours for any additional changes. Office will close one hour after last performance on Saturday evening.

REGISTRATION PAPERS

ASHA MEMBERSHIP CARDS

A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THE SHOW NUMBER IS RELEASED IF REQUESTED. Exception--Horses shown in US Equestrian Regular Member Shows prior to December 31, 1973 and Saddlebred-type ponies.

REFUNDS

Exhibitors canceling their entries after July 1st shall forfeit their entry fee and stabling charge. During the course of the show entry fees may be refunded only if the horse scratched is examined by the Official Show Veterinarian and certified unable to show. No refunds will be made during the show. NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.

OPEN CHECKS

An open check is required to be left in the horse show office for each exhibitor participating in the horse show to cover any miscellaneous costs including, but not limited to, class additions, or additional stalls used. An open check left by a trainer covering all exhibitors he/she is responsible for will suffice for this requirement. No back numbers will be released until an open check is on file in the horse show office. If the open check is used for any additional fees, the amount of the check will be made available at the close of the horse show, or an exhibitor/trainer may pick up their unused open check at the close of the show. Horse show management has the right to waive this requirement as they feel necessary. Checks will be cashed for initial entries.

WARM-UP AREA AND SHOW RING

Footing for the warm up area and show ring will consist of dirt and shavings. Show ring is approximately 100 x 200. Warm up ring approximately 50'x150'.

STAKE AND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW IN A STAKE OR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS, A HORSE OR PONY MUST BE PROPERLY ENTERED, SHOWN AND JUDGED IN A QUALIFYING CLASS IN THE SAME DIVISION. ENTRIES FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP & STAKE CLASSES, LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK, MUST BE MADE AND PAID FOR BEFORE 5:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, FOR SATURDAY NIGHT CLASSES. ENTRY FEES FOR ALL OTHER CLASSES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY BLANK, OR THE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED TO THE SENDER.

Exhibitors qualifying more than one horse may elect to show only one horse back without penalty.

If a Championship entry is paid by the deadline but is subsequently cancelled, no refunds will be given without an excuse from the official veterinarian.

Any class designated as a Jackpot class does not have to participate in a qualifying class to enter the class.

SCRATCHES

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH EXHIBITOR TO OFFICIALLY SCRATCH ENTRIES IN ANY EVENT IN WHICH THEY DO NOT PARTICIPATE. THIS INCLUDES ALL STAKE AND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES.

DIVISION OF CLASSES

All pleasure driving classes will be divided at 15 or over. All other classes will be divided

A \$25.00 FINE WILL BE LEVIED FOR FAILURE TO SCRATCH AN ENTRY AT LEAST ONE HOUR PRIOR TO SHOW TIME. IF A CLASS IS SUBSEQUENTLY DIVIDED, A \$100.00 FINE WILL BE LEVIED.

according to US Equestrian rules. In a divided class, separate trophies and ribbons will be awarded. Notification of intent to divide will be made one hour prior to the start of the session.

WHEELED TOYS/VEHICLES - WILL BE ENFORCED!

Bikes, skate boards, roller skates, scooters or any type of wheeled toy/vehicle is prohibited from the horse show grounds for any individual under the age of 16. This is being done for the safety of all individuals and horses participating in or watching the horse show.

DOGS

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be required to leave the show grounds.

TRAILER PARKING

Will be as it was in past.

CONTACT WITH JUDGES

No exhibitor/trainer may confer with the Judges.

JUDGING AND PRIZE DISTRIBUTION

Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.

STABLING / FEED AND BEDDING

Stalls consist of steel with reinforced plastic walls and wood. There are stall doors. Stalls will be available Tuesday afternoon, July 5, 2023. The cost of a box stall is \$160. Stalls will be assigned at the discretion of the show management. Each horse entered must have a stall. Payment for tack stalls must be received at the same time as payment of classes. Important: There will be no first day bedding. Shavings will be available on the grounds. Boards must be ordered by June 20, 2023 to guarantee your order.

DISPUTES

This show through its Protest Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising of, or incidents to the show without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. No dispute will be discussed while the show is in session.

PROTESTS

A protest must be made in writing, signed and accompanied by a deposit of \$250. The deposit fee can either be a check, made payable to ASAW Summerfun Horse Show or cash. The protest must be received by a member of the Protest Committee.

TEXTING/FACEBOOK

The horse show office will not accept ANY changes made by text message or Facebook instant message to the manager, secretary or assistant secretary in regards to cancelling or adding classes.

MEMBERSHIPS

Owners/Trainers of American Saddlebreds must be a current member of the American Saddlebred Horse Association and American Saddlebred Association of Wisconsin. Owners/Trainers of all Hackney Ponies or Horses must be a current member of the American Hackney Horse Association. Copies of current membership cards must be kept on file in the horse show office.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

\$30.00 Incomplete Entry Charge. Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/trainer/handler will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership, lease papers, if applicable, ASHA and AHHA membership cards must accompany entry blanks, which must include the REQUIRED three signatures and complete addresses for owners and trainers.

CLASSES BY DIVISION

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. All classes will be shown in order listed. Any changes deemed necessary by the horse show committee will be made in accordance with the US Equestrian regulations.

All horses shown in these divisions must be registered with the US Equestrian or the Canadian American Saddle Horse Registry. They must be entered in their full registered name with registration numbers and under the names of the owner record. Horses shown in a regular member show prior to December 31, 1973, and ponies are excepted.

PONY MEASUREMENT CARDS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION.

AMATEUR CARD

ALL AMATEURS, over age 18, must have available for inspection, a current US EQUESTRIAN AMATEUR CARD or make proper application at the show office one hour prior to class. Certification must be renewed annually.

WALK / TROT

10 & under Exhibitors may only participate in walk/trot 10 & under classes offered at the same show.

ASAW MEMBERS ONLY

Exhibitors (defined as owners, riders and trainers in performance classes) must be current members of ASAW (excludes Academy riders). Membership forms will be available in the Horse Show Office.

CLASSIC PLEASURE HORSE

Must be plain shod, rim pads or single pad (no wedges). Gingering is NOT permitted in Classic Pleasure.

Novice, Maiden or Limit Definition

Novice, Maiden or Limit Definition: Classes will count whether USEF rated or not, or whether shown at "A" or "B" rated shows.

COMBINING CLASSES

Summerfun Horse Show reserves the right to combine classes of the same division based on number of entries within a division. If this occurs, all entries in both classes will be notified by the show office. For example, Show Pleasure 13 & Under may be combined with Show Pleasure 14-17 if there are a limited amount of entries in either of the splits.

ABS SINGLE-BIT DIVISION

Single Bit classes are open to **Amateur or Juvenile** riders in a snaffle bit only (no curb bits or curb chains allowed), with a running martingale, German martingale or draw reign. All tack should be of show ring quality. Riders are to wear appropriate show ring attire. **Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into another division**, with the exception of the Model, Showmanship and Pattern classes.

Open Breed classes are open to any breed of horse, rider of any age, Professional or Amateur, unless class description specifically indicates amateur or junior exhibitor. To be shown in the appropriate attire for the division being shown in.

All classes are for the American Saddlebred breed unless specified in the prize list as Open Breed classes.

ACADEMY CLASSES

The purpose of this division is to introduce potential owners to the joys of showing horses and give riders the opportunity to gain experience in a fun horse show atmosphere. The UPHA Chapters 3/4 and 10 sanction these classes. A complete copy of the guidelines for these classes will be available at the horse show office.

RIDERS: Riders in this division are students who are enrolled in a professionally operated program and are to be judged on their basic riding skills. Riders may NOT cross enter into any performance classes with the exception of driving classes. A rider who has shown in a regular division class and/or in a full riding suit at any show is prohibited from further participation in the Academy division with the exception of the Open Rider Pleasure classes (if applicable).

RIDERS' ATTIRE: All riders are encouraged to use safety helmets. ASTM/SEI Approved Safety helmets are the only acceptable headgear for academy riders. **Helmets are required for ALL 10 and under riders.** Saddle Seat Attire: Jodhpurs or dark pants, shirt with a collar, tie, jodhpur boots or sturdy shoes. Sweater vest or fitted vest permitted; no derbies/hats. No full riding suits allowed.

HORSES: Horses are to be lesson-type horses. These horses must display the characteristics of such! Instructors are encouraged to own or lease their academy horses. Horses must not be in training. Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with martingale or a Pelham/full bridle. Appropriate saddles are to be used for the seat being ridden. Hoofblackening and ribbon braids are optional. Academy horses may cross-enter into other divisions at any show; however, show horses may not be entered into the Academy division. This means an academy horse is allowed to show in the Academy division and be cross-entered into other divisions (such as Pleasure, Country Pleasure, Pleasure Equitation) at the same show.

Green Rider: Green Rider is defined as an academy rider in their first calendar year of showing. Classes will be split by age group if warranted.

Advanced Lead Line Walk/Trot: Riders will be led in at a walk and worked each way of the ring. The riders will be individually trotted past the judge. Riders are expected to post, but correct diagonals are **NOT** required. Class will be judged.

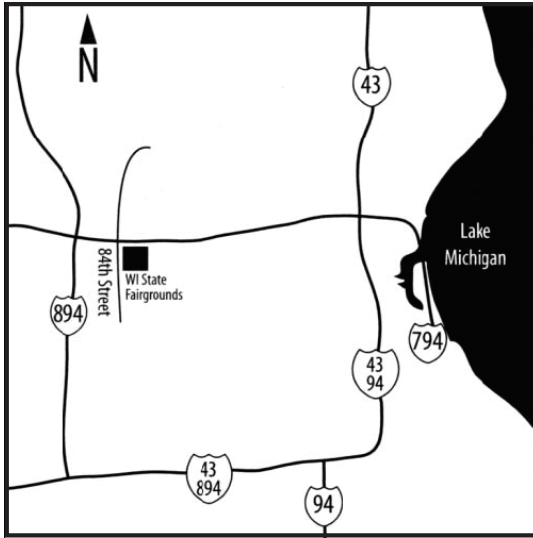
