RULES AND REGULATIONS: None of the UPHA Chapter 10 Saddlebred Horse Shows, UPHA Chapter 10 or its officers and directors, the owner of the facility, the show manager, or any employee, independent contractor or volunteer of the show shall in any way, jointly or individually, be responsible for, or have any liability for, any loss, accident, damage or loss, including loss of life, that may occur to any person, including any exhibitor, owner, trainer, agent, groom, stable, animal, spectator, any property or equipment, sustained at, or as a result of, the UPHA Chapter 10 Saddlebred Horse Show held at the facility in Woodstock, IL. All horses must be kept under control and, if they are not, they may be barred from competition and entry fees forfeited at the discretion of the show management. Every class offered which is covered by the rules of the current United States Equestrian Federation rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES & NEGATIVE COGGINS: All horses shipped into the State of Illinois must have the required health certificates issued by a veterinarian from the state or region. These must be available for inspection during the show and be in accordance with Illinois State Law. Negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia required for each horse within the prior 12 months.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS: Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. See USEF rule number: GR845 for complete rule.

ENTRIES CLOSE JANUARY 28TH, 2022

Entries close January 28th, 2022. There will be no exceptions. The uniform for the Winter Warm Up is the show long sleeve T-shirt. They need to be ordered after entries are received thus the strict deadline. There will be no exceptions to this. The show committee reserves the right to decline any entry and return the entrance fee. This committee may prohibit any one from attending or showing a horse. It also may remove any owner, stable employee, or horse from the ring or grounds without liability. Open checks required at check in.

WINTER WARM UP T-SHIRT IS ATTIRE FOR WINTER WARM UP: The attire for the competition is the Winter Warm Up Long Sleeve T-Shirt, jods and jod boots. Please specify T-shirt size on entry blank. No riding suits or academy outfits allowed.

RIDERS: The rider's age as of December 1st will be the age group said rider will compete in throughout shows for that season. Once the rider has cantered, the rider will NOT be allowed to return to the walk/trot classes. Riders cannot show walk/trot and walk/trot/canter at the same tournament.

EQUIPMENT: Horses must have a flat English type saddle in all saddle seat classes. Horses used in hunt seat or western classes must wear the appropriate saddles for those classes. Horses may wear any type of bridle. Any rider 10 years of age or younger MUST wear protective head gear. No braiding of manes or blacking of feet. Tails can be up or down. Wraps, splint boots and bell boots are permitted.

ACADEMY HORSES: Academy horses must be school type horses that are used regularly in a lesson program. A rider may show his or her own horse in an academy class as long as the horse is REGULARY used in a lesson program. These horses must be shown by more than the said owner of the horse at the competition. Academy horses MUST NOT be in training.

SHOW HORSES: Show horses may show in show practice classes, open training and new horse/new rider classes only.

RIBBONS & TROPHIES: Trophy for 1st place. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st – 8th place.

SCRATCHES: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to scratch an entry for a class in which he or she does not intend to participate. A \$25 fine will be levied for failure to scratch an entry two hours before show time. If a class is split there will be a \$100 fine.

SPLITS AND CANCELLATIONS: Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes due to the number of entries per class.

STABLING AND BEDDING: The cost of a box stall is \$65. Stalls will be assigned at the discretion of the show management. Each horse entered must have a stall. Payment for tack stalls must be received at the same time as payment of classes. Shavings must be ordered on the entry blank. No single day rates and NO STRAW BEDDING. NO OUTSIDE BEDDING ALLOWED. All bedding must be purchased from Beyond Stable Farm. When considering the cost of bedding, be aware that it includes the expense of delivery, clean up and disposal.

CAMPER HOOK UPS: Camper Hook-ups are available at \$50 per day. Make reservations at the time of entry. Payment for camper hook-up is payable at time of entry to the grounds. Please note that the hook ups include electric only.

WARM-UP RING SAFETY REGULATIONS: In an effort to insure the safest possible event, only participants (riders or drivers, trainers and grooms) are permitted in the warm-up area.

TWO MINUTE GATE RULE: A two minute gate rule will be enforced. Notify the horse show office in cases where a gate hold in excess of two minutes is required.

VET ON CALL: Phone number will be posted at show office.

PARKING: The use of the parking parcel to the North of the property is allowed. All vehicles and trailers shall park in a uniformed manner in this parking parcel only. No camping will be permitted on the parking parcels. No vehicle access shall be permitted to the parking parcels from Equine Drive. No emptying or loading of trailers will be permitted on Arena Drive.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

OPEN TRAINING CLASS: Open to all horses and disciplines. To be shown under saddle at the walk, trot and canter. Snaffle bridle is optional. Open to professionals and amateurs.

PRO AM CLASS: Amateur riders show first direction of the ring and the professional rides the second direction. Class will be shown at the walk, trot and canter.

SHOW PRACTICE CLASSES: Open to show and academy horses. Judged on the ability to present horse to the best advantage. Good class for show riders needing ring experience between show seasons. Also a good class to introduce a beginner show rider to the art of showing.

NEW HORSE/NEW RIDER CLASS: Class is designed for a first or second time team of horse and rider. This class should be used for show riders and show horses but is not limited to show horses. Full bridles are strongly suggested. Also a good class to introduce a new horse for schooling purposes.
NO PROFESSIONALS.

SHOW RIDER/ACADEMY HORSE CLASSES: Class is designed for show riders to get more practice showing on an Academy Horse.
NO SHOW HORSES.

ACADEMY WALK/TROT CLASSES: Academy Riders only. Anyone with regular show experience is prohibited. Open to riders that have not cantered at a show.

ACADEMY PLEASURE/SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES: No show horses. Academy Riders only. Judged 50% on basic riding skills and 50% on basic showmanship skills. Rider's ability to show horse is paramount.

PATTERN CLASSES: Open to all riders and academy or show horses. Pattern will be posted in the office.

ADVANCED LEAD LINE: Riders ages 7 & under will be led in at the walk and worked each way of the ring. The riders will be individually trotted past the judge. Riders are expected to post, but correct diagonals are NOT required. Class will be judged.

NOVICE RIDER: Open to riders that have not won three classes.
