EXHIBITOR INFORMATION – SHOW STATEMENT:

None of the UPHA Chapter 10 Saddlebred Horse Shows, UPHA Chapter 10 or its officers and directors, the owner of the facility, the show manager, or any employee, independent contractor or volunteer of the show shall in any way, jointly or individually, be responsible for, or have any liability for, any loss, accident, damage or loss, including loss of life, that may occur to any person, including any exhibitor, owner, trainer, agent, groom, stable, animal, spectator, any property or equipment, sustained at, or as a result of, the UPHA Chapter 10 Saddlebred Horse Show held at the facility in Woodstock, IL. All horses must be kept under control and, if they are not, they may be barred from competition and entry fees forfeited at the discretion of the show management. Every class offered which is covered by the rules of the current United States Equestrian Federation rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

ADMISSION OF HORSES

Horses will be admitted no earlier than 3:00 PM on Thursday April 29th, 2021. Warm Up Ring and arena will be available for use Thursday.

PARKING

The use of the parking parcel to the North of the property is allowed. All vehicles and trailers shall park in a uniformed manner in this parking parcel only. Trailers must be parked in approved trailer locations. Campers must be parked in approved camping locations only. No vehicle access shall be permitted to the parking parcels from Equine Drive. No emptying or loading of trailers will be permitted on Arena Drive.

BEDDING

No first bedding will be provided per stall. Shavings will be available at \$10 per bag from the show office. To pre-order bedding contact show secretary or include it on the entry blank. **NO STRAW BEDDING OR OUTSIDE BEDDING ALLOWED.** All bedding must be purchased from Beyond Stable Farm. When considering the cost of bedding, be aware that it includes the expense of delivery, clean up and disposal.

STABLING

All stalls are 10' x 10' with tongue and groove solid wood on three sides. Please note the facility prohibits putting screws or nails into the wood. Staples are acceptable. The floor is concrete.

CAMPING

Camper Hook-ups are available at \$30 per day. Make reservations at the time of entry. Payment for camper hook-up is payable at time of entry to the grounds. Please note the hook-ups include electric only.

DOGS

Dogs must be kept on a leash.

WARM-UP RING SAFETY

In an effort to insure the safest possible event, only participants (riders or drivers, trainers and grooms) are permitted in the warm-up area during show time.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All horses shipped into the State of Illinois must have the required health certificates issued by a veterinarian from the state or region. These must be available for inspection during the show and be in accordance with Illinois State Law. Negative Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia required for each horse within the prior 12 months.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. **See USEF rule number: GR845 for complete rule.**

VETERINARIAN

Veterinary contact information posted in show office.

ENTRIES

Entries close April 16th 2021. All stall, drug and office fees as well as one entered class per horse must be paid for and postmarked by April 16th, 2021 to avoid the post entry fee. The show committee reserves the right to decline any entry and return the entrance fee. This committee may prohibit any one from attending or showing a horse. It also may remove any owner, stable employee, or horse from the ring or grounds without liability. Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/trainer/handler will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership, copies of current Coggins and ASHA membership cards must accompany entry blanks, which must include the REQUIRED three signatures and complete addresses for owners and trainers.

REFUNDS

Refunds will be made only when a veterinarian's certificate is presented before the start of the show. Refunds for entry fees only will be made if said certificate is received after the start of the show. Once the horse is on the grounds, only a veterinarian may issue said certificate. Stall fees and office fees cannot be refunded.

HORSE SHOW TAB/RETURNED CHECKS

All exhibitors wishing to run a tab MUST leave a blank, signed check in the show office before receiving numbers. All checks returned by the bank for insufficient funds will be subject to a \$50 fee charged by UPHA Chapter 10.

POST-ENTRIES

There will be a post entry fee of \$50 per horse on entries post-marked after show entry closing date of April 16th, 2021.

TWO MINUTE GATE HOLD

A two minute gate rule will be enforced. Notify the horse show office in cases where a gate hold in excess of two minutes is required.

SPLITS AND CANCELLATIONS

Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes due to the number of entries per class.

Academy classes are open to any rider presently enrolled in a professional operated riding lesson program. Riders must be on mounted school horses. Horse in academy classes may be owned by anyone but they cannot be in training and they **MUST** currently earn their living in a professionally managed riding lesson program. Riders may show their own horses in academy provided the horse is regularly used in a professional lesson program. Age of riders is as of December 1st, 2018.

ATTIRE: Jodhpurs or dark pants, a collared long sleeve shirt, tie, jodhpur boots or sturdy shoes. Sweater vest, sweater or fitted vest permitted; no habits or hats. **Helmets are strongly recommended and are required for 10 & under riders.**

EQUIPMENT: Horse must be shown in appropriate saddle (cutback or pleasure). Normal academy equipment (i.e. martingales, snaffles, etc.) permitted in walk-trot and walk-trot-canter classes. Wraps, splint boots, bell boots, and blinkers are permitted.

ADVANCED LEAD LINE: Riders will be led in at the walk and worked each way of the ring. The riders will be individually trotted past the judge. Riders are expected to post, but correct diagonals are NOT required. Class will be judged.

ACADEMY HORSEMANSHIP will be judged on the horse's manner and suitability. Horsemanship is paramount. **Diagonals WILL NOT count.** Backing not required. The overall appearance of any pleasure horse should depict a horse that enjoys what he is doing.

GREEN RIDER: A Green Rider is defined as rider that is competing in their first season of showing.

NOVICE RIDER: Open to riders that have not won three classes in their respective division (Walk & Trot and Walk/Trot/Canter).

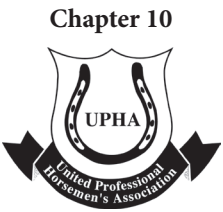
Walk-Trot riders may only enter walk-trot equitation and/or walk-trot pleasure classes. Walk-trot-canter riders may only enter walk-trot-canter equitation and/or walk-trot-canter horsemanship classes. Riders may not cross enter.

Trophies for first place, ribbons for first place through eight place.

EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS: Exhibitors must have been entered, shown and judged in their qualifying class to be eligible to enter respective championship. Management reserves the right to split the championship based on entries.
